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### Swimming will start on Monday 30 April 2018

Swimming is such an important skill; we are incredibly lucky to have our own pool. We need you to help us provide a safe and secure environment in which your children can learn to be independent in the water. Our reception children need the most help and so we ask for 4 parents to be in the pool, and 2 in each changing room. Year 1 and 2 children require 2 parents in the pool and 2 in each changing room. This year, Year 2 will swim for a longer weekly session. Year 1 will swim twice, and reception will swim on Fridays.

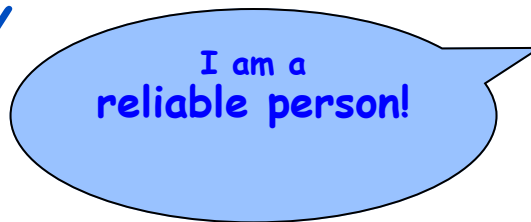
# Our Learning Behaviour is...
