The children have been enjoying cooking this week. Our Love the Ball coaches have taken some children through rugby skills while Sean the drumming teacher has had us making some great tunes!

In Year 1....

Year 1 have enjoyed learning about 2D and 3D shapes this week! Have a hunt around at home to see which shapes you can spot and name!

In science we have had lots of fun making electric circuits and lighting up bulbs.

We are continuing to enjoy our focus book and have been using adjectives to describe characters from the story.

In Year 2....

The children are immersed in their recycling topic, which has been supported by a great text called '10 things I can do to help my world' by Melanie Walsh. They are currently completing their own versions of the book and will be sharing them with some of the younger children in the school. Please do keep your clean, recycled materials coming in for junk modelling next week. We now have our first Green Team of the year, who, having being trained up by Mrs. Shepherd, are now doing their bit to help save energy and keep our school environment clean. This week they have been collecting leaves for composting.

We have just come to the end of an intense 3 weeks of arithmetic in which we have taught children two main strategies for addition and subtraction; the open number line and partitioning into Tens and Ones ("the column method"). These concepts and models are still being fully understood by many children and it is a case of practise, practise, practise. We will continue to focus particularly on mental arithmetic throughout the rest of the academic year.

Finally, we have our first trips of this term coming up. Next Monday 19th November, Leopard Class will be visiting Kingston Children's library, with Lions and Tigers visiting on Tuesday 20th. Thank you to the parent volunteers who have signed up to assist us. We would not be able to conduct educational visits without you. We are aiming to foster a love for reading. You can support this goal by ensuring that your child has their school library book in their blue bag on the correct day each week. We have loved welcoming in parents to read a book to the whole class at 3pm each day. Do let your teacher know if you'd like to do this too. The children absolutely love it!

On 19th December we will be taking the children to The Rose Theatre to see a production of Hansel and Gretel. Do let your teacher know if you are available to support that day too. Thank you.
