It has been another busy, action packed week. Our Country Dancers attended the Borough Country Dancing Festival, Year 1 had a wonderful trip to Painshill Park and we enjoyed our fantastic summer fair.

We have now reached the final month of this school year and we will be enjoying lots of activities to support transition. Today you have received an email informing you of your child's next class. Please talk to your child about this. When talking to your child about changes please try to be as positive as possible and acknowledge any worries they may have and reassure them. For our year 2 parents, please come along to our workshop next Thursday 4 July on transition. The workshop will be run by our Education Wellbeing Practitioner, Shazia.

During the INSET day on Monday staff will be discussing each child and gathering as much information as possible to make sure that the move will be as smooth as possible. Then on Wednesday 3rd July your children will be visiting their new class. You will have an opportunity to meet the new teacher on Tuesday 16th July 3.15-4.00 p.m. We have planned this with the Junior school so that there is plenty of time to meet your new teacher in the Infant school then move over to the Juniors.

New Reception children - parent/teacher meetings and Stay and Play sessions

We are beginning to get to know our new Reception families and we are enjoying welcoming you to Coombe Hill Infants. Punctuality

Unfortunately we have noticed an increase in the number of children arriving late for school recently. We expect every family to arrive at school on time with their child every school morning. It is disruptive to the classroom staff and unsettling for your child when they arrive late into a classroom when their classmates have already settled and started their learning. We track punctuality very closely and every reason given for lateness is recorded on their attendance record that they carry through their schools with them. We will be writing to families where there are concerns. We also expect every child to be collected promptly at the end of the day from their classroom door and we record all late collections, it can be upsetting for your child if they are not collected at the same time as their classmates.
