Dear Families,

This afternoon I held a prefect meeting and the children reported back that they have seen lots of kind, respectful, and caring play. It was lovely to hear. This is something we continually work on. Next week, we would like a focus on good manners- saying please and thank you, holding the door for others, and listening well. Please support this by talking to your children at home.

Our focus learning behaviour next week will be Kanga, who helps us to be Responsible. We are noticing that lots of children are leaving sweatshirts, hats, etc, out in the playground and in corridors. Please remind them to be responsible by looking after their belongings. A reminder that all school uniforms must be labelled, we are seeing a large amount of items in the lost property box which aren't named. Please check the box, which is located in the Year 1 playground, for any missing uniform. You will also find hats, water bottles, coats, swimming items and even the odd shoe in there.

#### **Punctuality**

Unfortunately, we are seeing an increasing number of children who are arriving late at school in the mornings. Even if your child is only a few minutes late, they can find it hard to settle, they also miss the introduction to the lesson. Teachers find this disruptive to the learning of the other children. The classroom doors open at **8.40 am**, please try to aim for this as it is a settling-in time. The doors and gate close promptly at **8.50 am**. We are also finding that an increasing number of children are being picked up late at the end of the day. Please pick your child up on time, our staff run clubs after school, and looking after late children makes things more difficult. We do understand if there is an emergency, but some children are regularly being picked up late. If you are late in the morning or afternoon, please fill in the monitoring form at the front desk.

#### Marking the VE Day 80th Anniversary in school



This afternoon we had a wonderful time celebrating the 80th anniversary of VE Day. We talked to your children about the importance of Peace. They enjoyed a whole school picnic on the adventure playground and then played on the field with the Junior children. The sun came out, and it was glorious!

#### **Year 3 Admissions forms**

A reminder to our year 2 parents and carers to please complete the Admissions forms for your year 3 transfer to the Junior school by **Friday 16 May at the latest.** If your child is not transferring to Coombe Hill Junior school in September please make us aware of this as soon as possible. #### **DBS** checks for parent volunteers

We are understandably bound by a strict checking process for DBS applications. Please note the following about the process involved. We understand that it can be a little time-consuming to gather together the correct paperwork needed but safeguarding is our key priority.

- We can ONLY accept financial letters, statements and documents received to your home address by post, NOT electronic copies of these documents nor screenshots
- You must provide dates and address details if you have EVER lived overseas, including if you were born overseas

- You must provide evidence of your name change history (ie birth certificate, marriage certificate, deep poll etc), if you have changed your name since birth
- We encourage every volunteer to sign up to the DBS update service within 28 days of receiving their certificate, this is free and allows any organisation (including the Junior school) to check your status without the need to reapply for a check - see <a href="https://www.gov.uk/dbs-update-service">https://www.gov.uk/dbs-update-service</a>
- We must see your original DBS certificate when you receive it please, bring it to the school office for us to take a copy

#### Warm and sunny weather - Sun cream and sun hats

Sun safety and high temperature policy - Summer 2024.docx

As the weather gets warmer, we would like to remind you about our Sun Safety Policy.

- Please apply at least factor 30 sunscreen before the school day.
- If your child needs to reapply sunscreen during the day, please show your child how to apply this
  safely. We recommend roll-on sunscreen in a bottle labelled with their name. Spray-on creams or
  rub-in creams will not be accepted. Refillable roll-on bottles are the cheapest option.
- Please give your child's named, roll-on sunscreen bottle to the class teacher and they will store it in a cool, dry place in the classroom.
- Sunscreen will be stored in a cool, dry place in the classroom
- Sunscreen will be self-administered by the child, under adult supervision, where possible.
- If your child has SEND or additional needs, a member of staff will apply the sunscreen, another
  member of staff will witness the application, and parental consent will be obtained beforehand. In
  this case, sunscreen will only be applied to pupils' faces, necks, and arms. Parental consent will be
  needed before staff can apply sun cream.

Please also remember to send your child into school with a named sunhat and full water bottles on sunny days. Please don't send in hand held fans. sunglasses (unless advised by a doctor).


