After school pick up on Friday, Infants school parents and carers are welcome to come to the school playground with their children to play until 3.45pm. All of the children are encouraged to come to school next Friday wearing their red, white and blue clothes.

Swimming reminders

We have been so fortunate to have enjoyed such warm weather for the children's first week of swimming. Thank you to everyone who has given their time this week to help with the sessions, the children simply could not swim without your support. Please keep an eye on your class's swim rotas and if you have a DBS certificate issued through the school please look to see where you can help.

We do have a couple of empty slots (as I write) on Thursday 8 May where we need 1 parent in the pool and 1 parent in the girls' changing room. If you are a Year 1 parent/carers who has a cleared, complete DBS check with us, please check if you are able to help on Thursday, thank you.

DBS checks for parent volunteers

We are understandably bound by a strict checking process for DBS applications. Please note the following about the process involved. We understand that it can be a little time-consuming to gather together the correct paperwork needed but safeguarding is our key priority.

- We can ONLY accept financial letters, statements and documents received to your home address by post, NOT electronic copies of these documents nor screenshots
- You must provide dates and address details if you have EVER lived overseas, including if you were born overseas
- You must provide evidence of your name change history (ie birth certificate, marriage certificate, deep poll etc), if you have changed your name since birth
- We encourage every volunteer to sign up to the DBS update service within 28 days of receiving their certificate, this is free and allows any organisation (including the Junior school) to check your status without the need to reapply for a check - see <https://www.gov.uk/dbs-update-service>
- We must see your original DBS certificate when you receive it please, bring it to the school office for us to take a copy

Warm and sunny weather - Sun cream and sun hats

As the weather gets warmer, we would like to remind you about our Sun Safety Policy.

- *Please apply at least factor 30 sunscreen before the school day.*
- *If your child needs to reapply sunscreen during the day, please show your child how to apply this safely. We recommend roll-on sunscreen in a bottle labelled with their name. Spray-on creams or rub-in creams **will not** be accepted. Refillable roll-on bottles are the cheapest option.*
- *Please give your child's named, roll-on sunscreen bottle to the class teacher and they will store it in a cool, dry place in the classroom.*
- *Sunscreen will be stored in a cool, dry place in the classroom*
- *Sunscreen will be self-administered by the child, under adult supervision, where possible.*
- *If your child has SEND or additional needs, a member of staff will apply the sunscreen, another member of staff will witness the application, and parental consent will be obtained beforehand. In this case, sunscreen will only be applied to pupils' faces, necks, and arms. Parental consent will be needed before staff can apply sun cream.*

Please also remember to send your child into school with a named sunhat and full water bottles on sunny days. Please don't send in hand held fans. sunglasses (unless advised by a doctor).

Planned absences from school

For any planned term time absences please see the following information. We strive for every child to be in school every day in order to maximise their education, learning and progress and wherever possible encourage you to arrange appointments and all holidays/travel during the 175 days of non-term days per year.

- **Authorised absences**
If your absence request is for a hospital appointment, an emergency dental appointment, a religious observation (where the day is exclusively set apart for religious observance), a visit to another school, an entrance/ballet/music exam, please request a form from the school.
- **Unauthorised absences**
If your leave of absence request is for any other reason than those given above **you must submit your request in writing (by letter or via email to to admin@chi.rbksch.org) giving full details, at least 2 weeks in advance** of the intended absence period, addressed to Mrs Berry. Our Attendance and Absence policy is always available on our website.

Our overall attendance target is 96%. Our overall attendance this week is 96.6%. Ladybird class has achieved the highest attendance this week, with 99.67% attendance, closely followed by Otter class with 98.28%. Well done to both classes.
