Covid vigilance

We continue to take every precaution to minimise the risk of a Covid outbreak within the school as we enter the winter months. Everyone in our community has their part to play. We do understand that it can be frustrating and inconvenient if called and asked to collect your child and arrange a PCR test if they display symptoms in school. Your child's attendance record is not negatively affected if they are absent waiting for a Covid test result. Test results are coming back usually within 48 hours or less at the moment and it is so important that we detect any potential cases in order to keep our school safe and operating smoothly. Could we please remind you of the following:

Covid symptoms: **Any one** or all of the following - a cough **or** a raised temperature **or** loss of sense of taste or smell

Covid testing: LFT tests (home test kits): For people who do not have any Covid

symptoms

PCR tests (at a test site): For people who do have one or more Covid

symptom

LFT home test kits are available from our School Office. PCR tests should be booked via https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test. Please continue to wear a face mask on the school site and definitely if you need to enter the building. If you are exempt from wearing a mask please make this clear. Thank you for your ongoing co-operation.

Parent Volunteers

We are very grateful to those parents who have volunteered their time to help in school recently. You must have your DBS certificate in place before you can come in so please arrange this with the School Office before you offer to help. We ask every parent to wear a face mask when coming in to school and ideally take a Lateral Flow Test the morning before you come in. Please can anyone who is exempt from wearing a face mask do an LFT before you come in each time. Thank you.
