

# **Summer Fair 2022 - Saturday 18th June 12-4pm**

The Coombe Hill Summer Fair will take place in just about 3 weeks! Stalls have been allocated and your class reps should be getting in touch with you all shortly about help - please help where you can!

Donations start from Monday 6 June so please see the information below about when we would like donations to come in and also please have a look at home during the half term to see if you have things you are able to donate. **Collection points for donations are outside the Juniors and Infant offices.**

**FRIDAY 17th JUNE IS A MUFTI DAY FOR BOTH THE INFANT AND JUNIOR SCHOOLS. DONATIONS OF BOTTLES AND/OR CHOCOLATES WILL BE COLLECTED AT THE SCHOOL GATES.**

**W/C 6<sup>th</sup> June** - Donations of filled Jam Jars (it will be very helpful if it's filled with wrapped sweets, small toys etc). We also accept cleaned empty jam jars; donations of Books, DVDs (PG rated only e.g. Peppa Pig) + second hand uniform (washed and in good condition).

**W/C 13<sup>th</sup> June** - Donations of Toys, Games, complete puzzle etc - 'in good and working condition'. It will help tremendously if you are able to wipe clean the toy before you donate it to the school. If it's not in good condition, then please recycle elsewhere - we are not a dump for broken/damaged toys.

**17<sup>th</sup> June and 18<sup>th</sup> June**- donations of whole cakes / cupcakes / cookies / jelly etc. for the desserts and refreshments stall. These should be taken to either of the school offices on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> June or straight to the stall on the Saturday 18<sup>th</sup> June. They should be in airtight containers to keep them fresh. Any containers you want back should be clearly labelled with name/class. This stall is popular in celebrating the amazing talented bakers we have in the Coombe Hill Schools!

## **International food**

If you can donate international food (such as curries, lasagne, chilli, pizza etc) please contact the Tiger class rep (Mahvish) or fill in the donation form from the office. This is a very popular stall - possibly the most popular! The Coombe Hill Schools have such a diverse community and this is a chance for parents to introduce their national signature dishes or even the family favourite dishes on this special day. Please donate if you can! Unfortunately, we cannot accept food that contain nuts.

**Second hand sports equipment stall:** Second hand bicycles, scooters and battery-operated cars, rollerblades and skates, must all be in good working condition and with functioning brakes on bikes/scooters. Please bring items in before the start of the fair, or any time on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> June. **Please note that items must be clearly labelled with your name and child's class and how much you want to sell it for including any special instructions.** If you don't label the item, it will be treated as a donation. Please be realistic about price. **Unsold items must be taken away again after the fair.** The school will accept no responsibility for any problems subsequently discovered, neither will the PTA be able to pass on any contact numbers for sellers, so as the saying goes, "buyer beware". The PTA will take 50% of the sales price.

**Swimming Pool Stall:** The first batch of tickets will be made available to buy on ParentPay for both Schools. Tickets can sell out quickly, so book early. Each time slot is restricted to maximum 40 people. If you only bring infant school or younger children, the Parent to Children ratio is 1:2; If any of your children is from Junior school or older, the ratio is 1:3. Any infant school or younger children must be accompanied by a parent **in the pool**. If all your children are from junior school or older, you have the option of not going into the pool but still need to buy the ticket to be with the children. Any unsold tickets will be sold at the gate during drop off/pick up on the week of 13 June.
