Delivery:- Offered as a blended learning delivery with use of the two workbooks with a tutor offering learning/taught sessions online every other week

You will need access to a computer, laptop or tablet and an internet connection. If you do not have the necessary IT equipment you can still apply as there may be the opportunity for equipment loan, depending on personal circumstances.
