Course Summary

This course is ideal if you are thinking of working in a school. You will learn about:

- The teaching and learning environment in a school setting,
- How to support the well-being of a child or young person and child,
- A young person's development.
- Schools as organisations
- How to keep children and young people healthy, safe and well
- How to communicate with children, young people and adults

You do not need to be working or have a placement in a school to join this course.

At the end of the course you will gain a Level 1 Award in Preparing to Work in Schools.

Progression after this course

Learners can progress onto:

- Level 2 Award in Support Work in Schools and Colleges
- Level 2 Certificate in Supporting Teaching and Learning
- Level 3 Diploma in Supporting Teaching and Learning (subject to Maths and English GCSE grades).
