Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that you all have a relaxing, healthy half term break. Your children have had a very busy few weeks and are coping really well. Our youngest children in particular find this time of year most difficult. They have to adjust to so many new things and it can sometimes be a little overwhelming for them. Please talk to us if your child is worried about anything. It is so important that they enjoy school life and feel comfortable in their environment. Many children struggle with sleep and bedtime routines and this can have a significant impact on their ability to stay focused and happy at school. Covid update

I am sure you are all aware that local and national infection rates for Covid are on the increase. We are just beginning to see a few cases amongst our children and staff and we are concerned that next half term will present some challenges. Please continue to be vigilant and supportive of how we are managing this situation. If your child has a cough or a temperature we will expect you not to send them in to school. If they develop a cough or a temperature during the day we require you to pick them up as soon as you can and then take them for a PCR test. We know that this can sometimes feel like an inconvenience or even an overreaction, however our priority is to keep everyone safe and we feel that this overrides everything.

Staff have requested that you wear masks when talking to them at the door or when on the school grounds - please respect this and co-operate with us. We have also considered reducing things like whole school assemblies to avoid further spread and will continue to monitor the situation carefully after half term. Over half term please let us know if your child tests positive for Covid so that we are aware of all cases within our school community and can take any necessary precautions. Ideally we would like all children to take an LFT before they return on Monday 1 November so that any asymptomatic cases can be identified and isolated, we would appreciate your help with this.

It was great to see almost all parents at the parent / teacher meetings this week. It is so important that we work in partnership with you. We will follow up on any families who were unable to meet the teacher after half term.
