Dear Parent / Guardian,

If your child missed their Flu Vaccination (Nasal Spray) at school, there will be another opportunity to receive the vaccine at the community walk-in clinic. This is open for all Primary aged Children (R- Year 6) and Years 7-11 of Secondary, who attend schools in Kingston and Richmond. Please note there will <u>not</u> be another opportunity after this.

Saturday 15th January 2022: Heathfield Junior School, entrance will be on Powder Mill Lane. TW2 6EX 10am-2pm.

(Entrance next to Children's Centre via Powder Mill Lane. No parking in school but free street parking)

Saturday 22nd January 2022: Southborough High School, KT6 5AS 10am – 2pm.

(Entrance to school immediately after the Shell Garage on Hook Roundabout off the A3, parking onsite).

<u>Upon arrival the parent / guardian will be asked to complete a consent form for your child</u>, before being directed to the next available nurse. We kindly ask, that once your child has received the vaccine you leave the building via the designated exit to allow for a smooth running of the session and to maintain social distancing.

You will not need to contact us to book an appointment, however, there may be a small queue so please be prepared to wait outside.

To help protect everyone please adhere to the following:

- One parent or guardian only to attend with the child(ren) who are to be vaccinated please. This is to maintain social distancing within the hall.
- <u>For students in School Years 10 or 11 only</u> if you are attending without a parent or guardian you will be advised to remain in the hall for 15 minutes after your nasal flu spray.
- For those aged 12 and above please wear a face covering (unless exempt) when entering the building
- Please sanitise yours and your child's hands when entering the building Please do not attend if you have or are:
- Self-isolating due to contact with a positive Covid-19 test or living with someone awaiting a test result.
- Showing any symptoms of Covid-19 to include a raised temperature, new continuous cough, loss of smell or taste.
