

Year 1 Home Learning Tasks for Spring 2

Choose some activities from each box to complete at home.

READING

Please encourage your child to read to you for 5-10 minutes every day. Also, please read to your child as often as you can and take time to discuss what is read to improve their comprehension.

- *Write a book review of your favourite book*
- *Illustrate and describe a character from a book*
- *Find three words to look up in the dictionary*

WRITING

- *Make a diary of your day*
- *Write a non-fiction Space story*
- *Make a poster to share facts about the Solar System*
- *Look around your house for objects that start with each letter of the alphabet. Write a list of them all in order.*
- *Write a spring poem and decorate it*
- *Write detailed instructions for washing your hands*
- *Make a comic strip about your family*

MATHS

- *Practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.*
- *Look for 3D shapes around the home– take a photo and label them!*
- *Practise telling time to the hour and half past the hour*
- *Measure your family. Who is the tallest?*
- *Make your own board game with number questions*
- *Ask your family what their favourite fruits are. Make a tally chart of their answers.*
- *Play ‘guess my number’ using mathematical questions (is it odd? Is it a multiple of 5?etc)*

Science

- *Find out about what keeps you healthy– keep a record of the healthy things you do each day*
- *Draw a shadow and keep track of it throughout the day. What do you notice?*
- *Go on a spring flower hunt. Press some flowers in a book.*
- *Carefully take apart a flower and look at the different parts. Stick them on paper and label them.*

Humanities

- *Find out some facts about Yuri Gagarin, Helen Sharmin or Galileo Galilei and make a poster about their achievements*
- *Write a letter to Tim Peake asking questions*
- *Download the SkyView app and find out about constellations*

Art/ DT

- *Go outside and use natural resources to make a picture or pattern*
- *Draw a detailed self portrait using a mirror*
- *Using crayons to make rubbings of items around the house*
- *Make a spring collage*
- *Sketch and label some Spring flowers*
