Rainbow Words

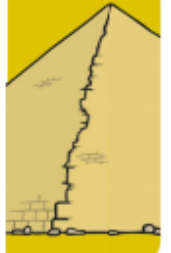
First write your spelling words in pencil. Trace over the words 5 times using a different coloured crayon each time.
